Using Dramatic Play and Art to Learn and Practice Friendship Skills

At the Creative Arts Social Club, we combine meaningful, direct instruction with uniquely-designed creative arts activities to help children develop and refine their social skills. Our small camps (2-6 students) ensure a safe, supportive environment where each child's social understanding, confidence and skills can grow.

At camp, children are immersed in a week-long social learning experience. Essential social thinking concepts are taught and practiced in all of our activities, resulting in fun, playful, experiential learning.

Our dramatic play and story-building activities teach effective interpersonal strategies and increase your child's ability to read and respond to social cues. Our group art and construction projects promote collaboration, cooperation and successful participation in a shared group experience.

Each morning is filled with engaging, hands-on activities with high kid-appeal. Week-long camps are for girls or boys who will benefit from learning why and how to follow "the group plan," be a flexible thinker, and participate successfully in a group learning/group play environment.

Children attend a no-fee, individual meet-and-greet visit prior to enrolling, to identify target areas for growth and ensure learning-compatibility with fellow campers. Students placed in the same session show overlap in their social strengths and "growing edges." This compatibility means that in some areas your child will be an expert, while in others s/he will be a novice. Experiencing oneself as capable in some areas with room for growth in others boosts self-confidence while social competence develops.

Your child will be led by Jahna Pahl, MA, drama therapist and social learning specialist with a private teaching practice on Mercer Island. A CIT (counselor-in-training) will assist Jahna each day.
